We should be much obliged to learn if you could supply us with tubing made of this material, which should be as light and inexpensive as possible; if so, will you please quote us your price for the same, and also forward us a sample of the material. We should require the tubes to be about 4" inside diameter, and in length of 65½ feet, and the material should ensure the tubes being waterproof for one year and also airproof.
