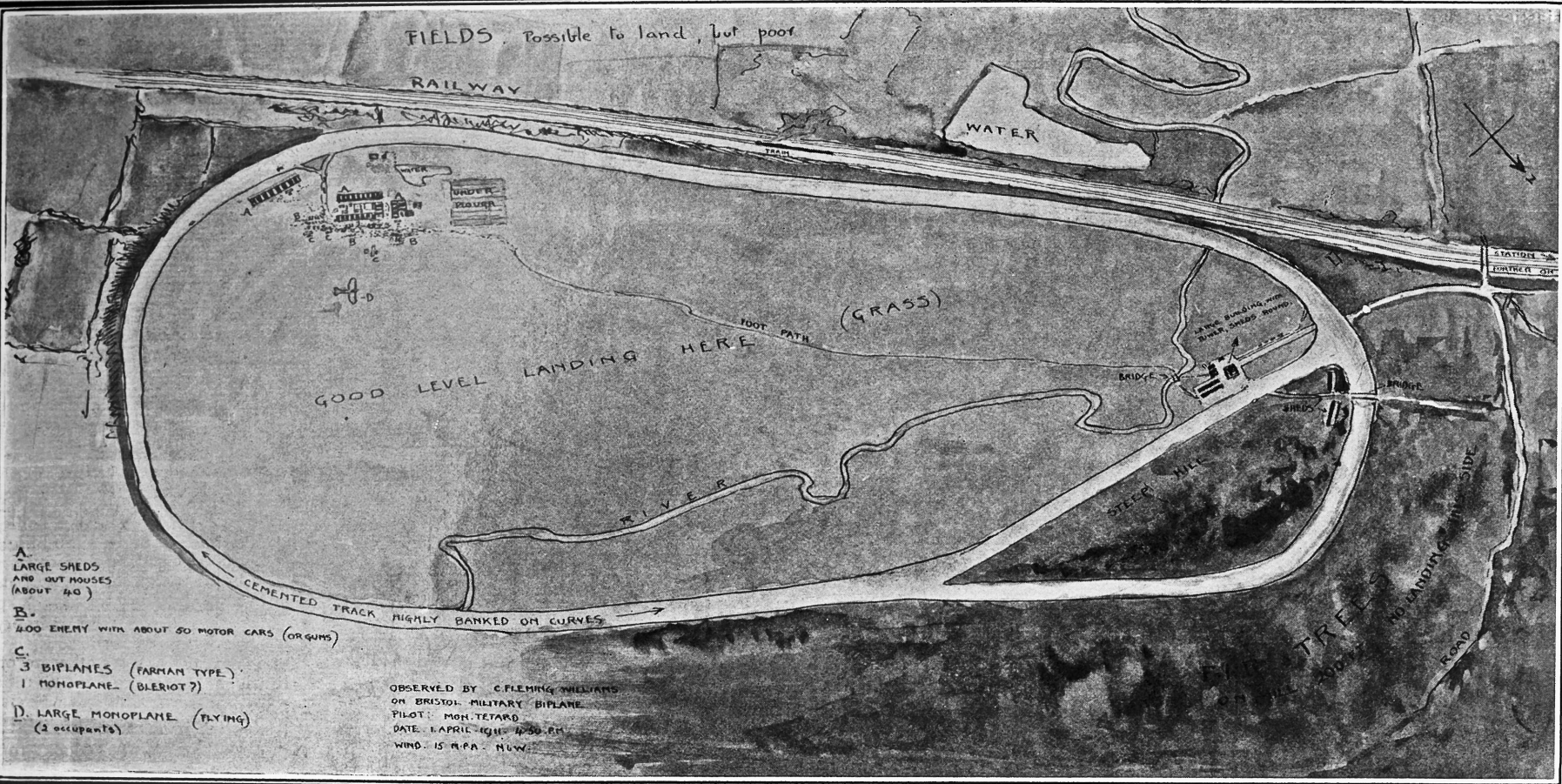




FIELDS. Possible to land, but poor
